

New service to Gatineau after O-Train Line 1 opens

Bus routes are changing October 6

- ✓ These changes will improve connections to O-Train Line 1 and replace the current service between downtown Ottawa and Gatineau on OC Transpo bus Routes 44, 105, 234 and 293.
- ✓ Seven new bus routes to Gatineau will connect with Line 1, either at **Pimisi Station** or at **Lyon Station**.

Routes serving Gatineau

From Lyon Routes 15 and 17

- ✓ Peak-period weekday service to destinations on Laurier and Maisonneuve with connections to Rideau, Parliament and Lyon Stations
- ✓ Route 15 also provides service between Gatineau and Lyon Station every 30 minutes during the day on weekdays

From PimisiRoutes 61, 63 and 75


- ✓ Rapid Route peak-period extension from Tunney's Pasture, Bayview and Pimisi Stations
- ✓ During the morning rush hour, some trips continue from Tunney's Pasture directly to Terrasses de la Chaudière in Gatineau, and return from Place du Portage in the afternoon

Route 66

✓ Service from Gatineau during the morning rush hour to NDHQ Carling Campus and Kanata North, and return trips to Gatineau in the afternoon

Route 85

✓ Frequent all-day bus service to Terrasses de la Chaudière with connections to Line 2 at Carling Station and Line 1 at Pimisi Station

Where you are going in Gatineau?

Terrasses de la Chaudière

Connect with Line 1 at Pimisi Station. Buses travel every 4 or 5 minutes during peak periods.

Frequent service is also provided in all time periods on **Route 85,** every day of the week.

Place du Centre and Place du Portage

Connect with Line 1 at Lyon Station.

Buses travel between Lyon and your destination on Maisonneuve Boulevard every 4 or 5 minutes during peak periods.



CONNECT TO STO AT NO EXTRA CHARGE

Société de transport de l'Outaouais (STO) also operates buses to and from Lyon Station that travel to Maisonneuve Avenue or Hôtel-de-Ville.

Many STO buses also connect at Parliament and Rideau Stations, or on Wellington Street – the Travel Planner and **sto.ca** provide more information about STO buses.
