

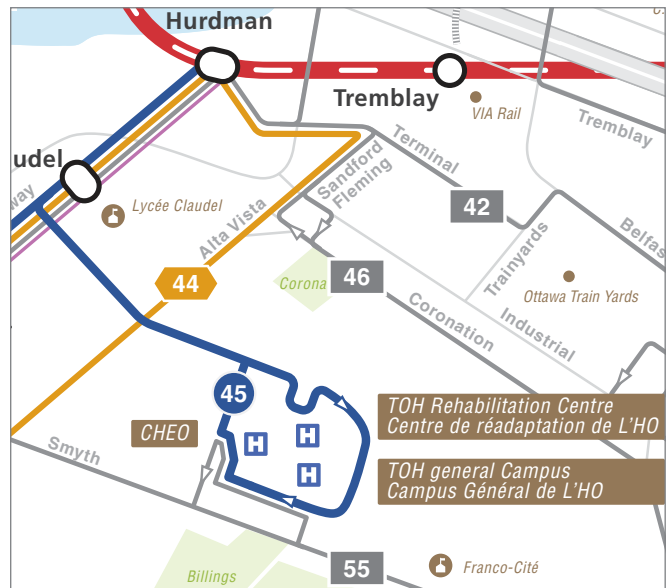
Service to Ottawa Hospitals after O-Train Line 1 opens

Quick and affordable connections to Ottawa hospitals

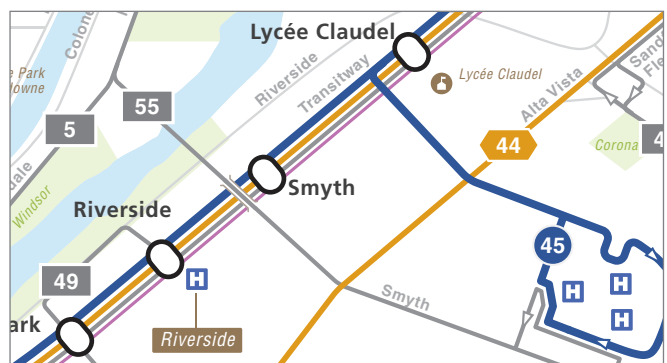
The Ottawa Hospital General Campus, CHEO, Rehab Centre

- ✓ **Lees and Hurdman Stations** are your O-Train Line 1 connection points for the Ottawa Hospital General Campus, CHEO and the Rehab Centre on Smyth Road.
- ✓ **Rapid Route 45** operates all day, seven days a week from Hurdman Station
 - Overnight, when Line 1 is not running, Route 45 Night service will continue beyond Hurdman Station to Rideau Station downtown.
- ✓ **Route 55 (new)** operates Monday to Saturday with a connection to Line 1 at Lees Station. Sunday service runs between the hospital and Elmvale only.



The Ottawa Hospital Riverside Campus

- ✓ Line 1 connections to Riverside Campus are available at **Hurdman Station**.
- ✓ Catch **Routes 10, 40, 48, 49, 88, 90, 92, 93, 96, 97, 98, and 99, 290, 291, 294 and 299** at Hurdman Station for service to Riverside Station, which is connected to the hospital campus.



Montfort Hospital

- ✓ **Route 20** serves Montfort seven days a week, connecting to O-Train Line 1 at St-Laurent Station.



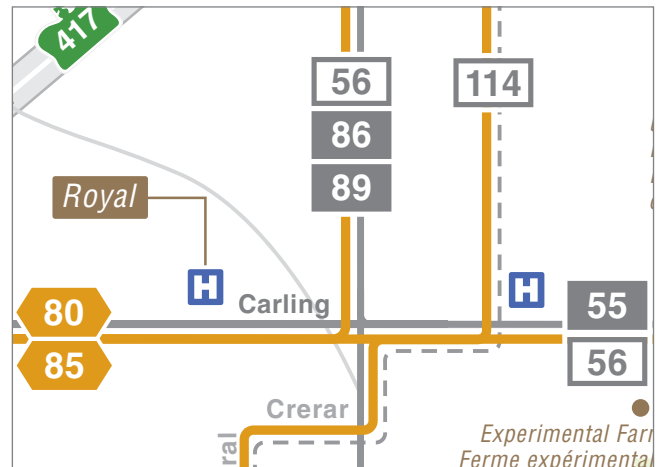
The Ottawa Hospital Civic Campus

- ✓ Use **Tunney's Pasture or Pimisi Line 1 stations** to connect to the Ottawa Hospital Civic Campus on Carling Avenue or Carling Station on Line 2.
- ✓ **Frequent Routes 53 and 85** serve the Ottawa Hospital Civic Campus
 - Route 53 connects to Line 1 at Tunney's Pasture Station.
 - Route 85 connects to Line 1 at Pimisi Station and Line 2 at Carling Station.
- ✓ **Local Routes 55 and 56** connect to Line 1 at Lees Station and to Line 2 at Carling Station.



The Royal

- Use Tunney's Pasture or Pimisi Stations to connect to the Royal Ottawa Hospital on Carling Avenue
- ✓ Frequent **Routes 80 and 85** serve The Royal seven days a week. Route 80 connects to Line 1 at Tunney's Pasture Station, and Route 85 connects at Pimisi Station.
 - ✓ Local **Route 55** serves The Royal from Monday to Saturday, connecting to O-Train Line 1 at Lees Station and O-Train Line 2 at Carling Station.



Queensway-Carleton

- ✓ **Rapid Route 57** and **Frequent Route 88** serve the Queensway-Carleton Hospital seven days a week.
 - Route 57 connects with Line 1 at Tunney's Pasture Station.
 - Route 88 connects with Line 1 at Hurdman Station.
- ✓ **Local Route 58** (formerly 152) provides seven-days-a-week service to the hospital from Moodie and Iris Stations.
