

### Bus routes are changing

On October 6, bus routes will change to make it even easier to connect to the train. Most routes will no longer travel through downtown, and will connect to Line 1 at one of thirteen new O-Train stations.

Transfer from Line 1 to a Frequent, Rapid or Local bus route to connect to other destinations outside the central area.

Find out what's changing, how to get to the O-Train, and how you can take advantage of the guick, reliable and frequent O-Train service that is transforming public transit in Ottawa.

### **O-Train connection at Tunney's Pasture**

Bus routes from the west will end at Tunney's Pasture Station, where you can make an easy transfer to O-Train Line 1.

From Tunney's Pasture, Line 1 provides frequent, reliable service through downtown Ottawa to central destinations such as the ByWard Market, uOttawa, and VIA Rail.

Frequent, Rapid, and Local bus routes at Line 1 stations connect directly to Gatineau, Ottawa Hospital campuses, the Airport, and east-end communities such as Vanier, Alta Vista, and Orléans.

# **NDHQ Carling**

### **Line 1 connection to Carling Campus and Moodie**

Route 58 provides an all-day connection to Carling Campus from Lincoln Fields, Iris Station, Bayshore, and Moodie Station.

Route 66 travels to Moodie Station and Carling Campus from Gatineau, Tunney's Pasture and Lincoln Fields Station in the morning rush hour, and returns in the afternoon.




### **Bus service directly to Gatineau**

During the morning rush hour, some trips on Rapid Route 75 will continue from Tunney's Pasture directly to Les Terrasses de la Chaudière in Gatineau, and will return from Gatineau in the

### Night service connects at Rideau Station














Overnight, when O-Train Line 1 is not running, Rapid Route N75 is extended from Tunney's Pasture through downtown to Rideau Station, making connections with other overnight bus service.














Line 1 connects to Line 2 at Bayview Station for a guick trip to Carleton University. During rush hours, some trips on Route 75 also travel directly to Bayview.

uOttawa campuses are located directly on Line 1.

Bus routes from Barrhaven serve Algonquin College at Baseline Station. If you use Connexion Route 283 from Richmond, transfer at Lincoln Fields.

Lees Station is your connection point for Saint Paul University on Main Street.

Bus routes 15, 25 and 39 provide a guick connection to La Cité at Blair Station.





Route 73 provides a new peak-hour connection between Tunney's Pasture and RCMP headquarters on Leikin Drive. Routes 80 and 199 will continue to serve Leikin; Route 199 will end at Hurdman Station instead of travelling to Orléans.






Hurdman Station is your Line 1 connection point for the Ottawa Hospital General Campus, CHEO and the Rehab Centre on Smyth Road.



Line 1 connections to the Riverside Campus are available at Hurdman and Greenboro.









Routes 55, 80 and 85 all connect to the Royal Ottawa Hospital on Carling.
