


will continue to provide 24/7 service to the airport, connecting with O-Train Line 1 at Hurdman Station for service to downtown. Route 97 also connects with Line 2 at Greenboro Station.

At Hurdman and Greenboro, customers connect to buses inside a fare-paid zone, meaning you don't have to pay a second fare when transferring.

Overnight, **Route 97 Night service** will continue beyond Hurdman Station to Rideau Station downtown for connections to other Night Routes.



Central Bus Station



Ottawa's Greyhound Bus Station is the main terminal for all intercity buses arriving in or leaving Ottawa.

Routes 6 and 7 provide all-day, weeklong service along Bank Street. Both Routes connect to Line 1 at Rideau and Parliament Stations.

Route 55 (new) provides Monday to Saturday service with connections to Line 1 at Lees Station and Line 2 at Carling Station.
